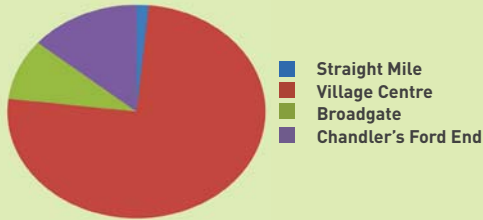
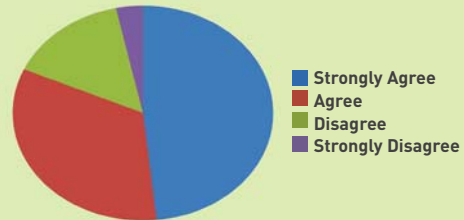


The pie chart analysis below summarises the contents of the 60 written questionnaire responses received

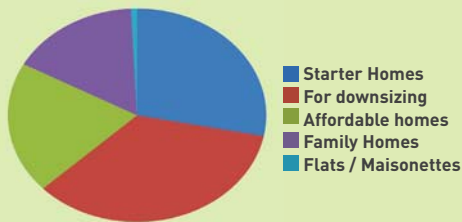
If new housing is to occur within the parish, where would you best like it?



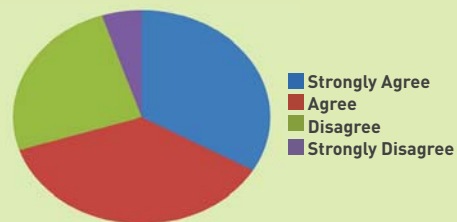
There is a need to support and improve local facilities:-



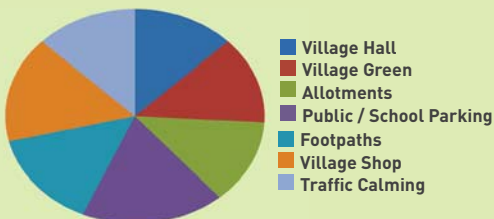
What type of housing is needed?



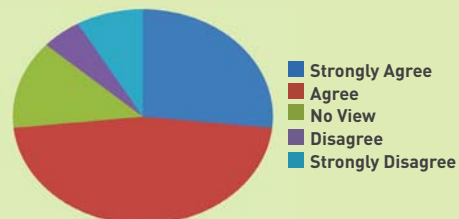
There is a need for enhanced provision of pedestrian linkages within Ampfield?



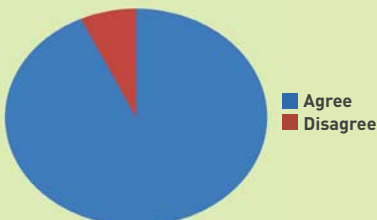
Any new housing should seek to provide for the following:-



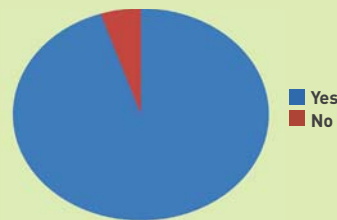
The Morleys Green site has the potential to accommodate new housing facilities:-

Public Exhibitions at Ampfield Village Hall and Millers Dale on Housing Need in Ampfield

Update

Since the public exhibitions at Ampfield Village Hall on the 24-25 June 2011 and Millers Dale on 2 July 2011, some 60 questionnaire responses have been received by Pegasus Planning Group and analysed. A summary of the responses is outlined here.

- The following number of persons visited the exhibition - 117

Key Findings

- The Consultation event was considered informative.
- For those supporting new housing in the village, the greatest support was for new homes for those wishing to 'downsize', followed by new 'Starter Homes'
- The strongest support for new housing, were it to take place, was on a site in the 'village centre'
- There was a strong desire to maintain the existing designated Local Gap between Ampfield and Chandlers Ford.
- The Morleys Green site had the potential to accommodate new housing and other local facilities.
- There was also selected objection to any form of housing development in Ampfield Parish.
